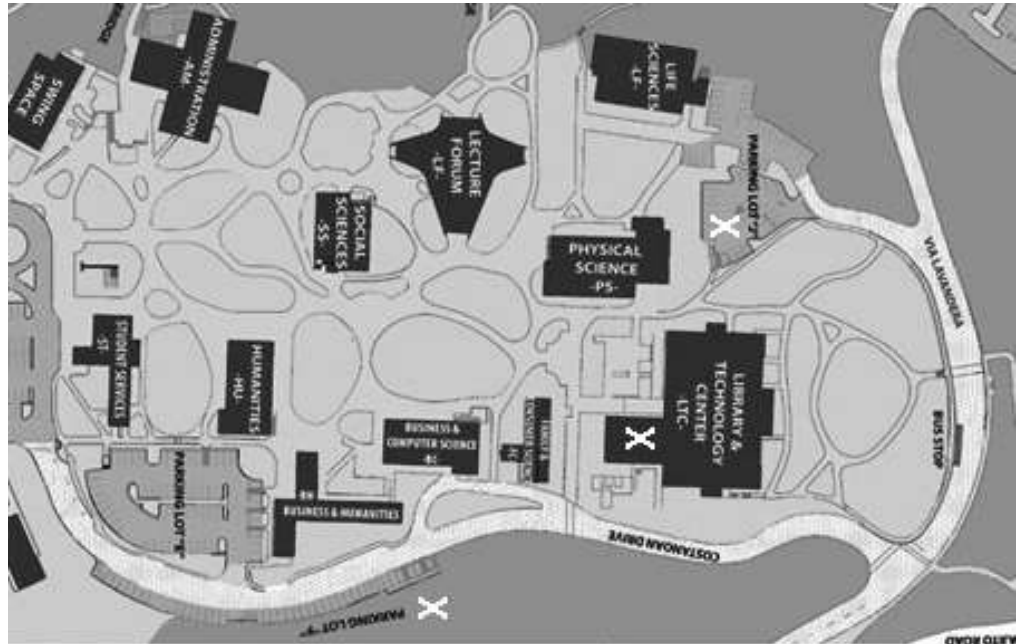

Directions to Monterey Peninsula College, 980 Fremont St., Monterey, California:

From: Highway 1 north, exit on 'Monterey' exit and get into left turn lane;

Turn left at stop light, then get into right lane;

Turn right at the next turn (going up the hill) and continue straight for Lot 'J' or continue left to park along the road.

Walk short distance to Library/Technology Center, Sam Karas Room (outside the main lobby) to Registration area.
